The winter/spring forecast calls for gloomy skies. So grab a suitcase and head for a little sunshine. No room in your carry-on for a blowdrier? No worries. Let your polished hair go on vacation with you and surrender to what you were born with. Hair expert Jet Rhys says you can pack light and still keep your hair looking seaside fabulous.

ESSENTIALS FOR YOUR SUITCASE

Curly: Use a curl enhancing shampoo and conditioner such as Bumble & Bumble's Curl Conscious. After conditioning, squeeze out all the water and apply a quarter-sized amount of Curl Conscious Cream to damp hair. Flip your head and work the product in really well from root to tip, while scrunching with your fingers.

Quick Tip. Pack a set of magic markers to loop around your hair for bouncy curls. To remove, just pull straight down and curls will go undisturbed. Don't touch or you'll create frizz.

Wavy: Jet suggests Davines' Love Shampoo and Conditioner for Lovely Curl Enhancing, formulated for wavy or curly hair. Afterward, apply a conditioning serum such as Davines' Momo Serum and get three Velco rollers (size depends on length of hair). Take your hair straight up and roll down, splitting it into three sections. This will define your waves and spread them evenly throughout your hair.

Accessorize that hair. Bobby pins or pretty clips randomly placed in your waves can add to your "straight from the surf" style. Try a double-headband to show off your sun-kissed glow.
