## Go Asymmetric



After a summer full of fun, get a fresh start! This fall, it's all about getting a look that is gorgeous and glamorous. Spice it up with a sultry asymmetric look. Asymmetric hair is being reinvented on runways across the world this fall, drawing inspiration from the past. These tips from Jet Rhys Salon in San Diego will help you stay sexy all season long!

## Shift Your Shape

The asymmetric look is always fresh and modern, especially when you add a sophisticated finish like sultry silver screen legend Veronica Lake. Blow-dry straight and then use a curling iron to add bouncy curls through the ends of the hair. Run a small dollop of styling cream through the length of your hair, then twist loosely and pull forward to sit over one shoulder. For a less dramatic, but equally mysterious look, Jet Rhys suggests sweeping bangs to the side and letting them fall over one eye.

## Laid Back Luxe

The fresh natural look dominates again on this fall's runways, like at Chloé and Chanel. This look is easy to achieve and will make you appear polished all day long! First, straighten your hair with a flat iron. Finish it with a straightening product to hold the sleek shape. Part hair on the side and use the flat iron to take out any stray waves or curls. This style can work on any length of hair. To give hair extra sleekness and shine, use a spray-on shine product that contains silicone. Jet Rhys likes Bumble and Bumble's Gloss (\$29.00).

## ■ Dramatize

Draw attention to your glamorous hair by accessorizing with Hollie Ten earrings! ## Polish It Up! ■

Recreate the sophisticated look of Carolina Herrera in three simple steps! If your hair is curly or wavy, use a flat iron for a smooth start. Part hair in the middle and pull it back into a low, sleek ponytail. Tease the ponytail for fullness and roll into chignon, smoothing the top layer over the teased portion.

## ■ Retro Allure

The fall runway at Dolce and Gabbana featured a teased retro hairdo, inspired by the sixties. If you have medium or long hair, give this a try! Backcomb your hair, starting three to four inches from your scalp. This will give it added height around your crown and face. Pull a small section of hair at the front of your head and secure with a clip or bobby pins.

## Curly Chic ■

Sexy, glamorous curls dictated the look on Zac Posen's runway. To achieve this look, first spray hair with styling spray to help maintain hold and allow movement. Set hair in hot rollers, leaving rollers 2 inches from roots, creating a flat look around the face and at the top of head. For a retro feel, tease the ends of your hair. Part your hair in the middle.
