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RED-DY FOR A NEW HUE?

Don't forget about your brows when changing your hair color! Jet Rhys' brow guru Dani uses Cirepie face wax with calendula and rosemary oil (it takes away the sting), gently extracts any strays, then applies an ice compress for two minutes. She finishes by de-pigmenting the brows to blend with your new color. ■

CALLING ALL ANGELS

Halo (n.)- Jet Rhys created this new technique by using circular sections around the head, weaving out particular pieces of hair, putting them in foil, and then adding color (we love the new saffron color blended with butterscotch and honey copper). However, instead of coloring the whole strand of hair, Jet Rhys colors only the midsection of the strand. When you move your head, your new shiny color will peep out from the rest of your hair to look like the sun coming through the clouds. It's heavenly! ■

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
